



One of the biggest milestones in his journey has been being selected among the Top 4 students from India to represent the country at GitHub Universe 2025 in San Francisco, USA – a global developer conference hosted at the GitHub Headquarters. The visit is fully sponsored by Microsoft, and Sayan feels honored to carry the name of his college, his state, and his country on that global stage.

He is also proud to have been recognized as one of the Top 19 Gold Microsoft Student Ambassadors in India, and the first from Chhattisgarh to achieve this distinction. 




Day 2 shifted focus to implementation, with sessions exploring the journey "From Spark to Start-up." Participants prepared actionable 90-day innovation roadmaps specific to their districts, establishing milestones and accountability measures. The five-pillar framework—Intent, Curiosity, Empathy, Resilience, and Courage—provided participants with tools to cultivate innovation cultures within their schools.

A highlight was the guided tour of RISU's state-of-the-art facilities, including the Incubation Centre, Research & Development labs, Drone Lab, Google and Microsoft Labs, and Central Instrumentation Facility. These infrastructure showcases inspired participants to conceptualize similar innovation spaces within school settings.

NSS volunteers conducted a door-to-door survey covering 80 households, spreading awareness on cyber safety, digital use, health, and nutrition while collecting valuable community data.


